This program re-factors (sequences of) conventional note-spacing commands (\notes \NOtes \NOtes ...) in a measure into a single \anotes command. This is intended for "legacy" scores in order to take advantage of features only provided by **autosp**(1), such as "global" skips.

## **LIMITATIONS**

tex2aspc assumes that & and | (rather than \nextinstrument and \nextstaff) are used to separate instruments and staffs.

User-defined macros are not processed or expanded.
